Dear Sir:

Your brother, Nousin, Assoline Mourad, now living in Juarez, Mexico, asked me to a saist him in securing border crossing pirviliges for himself, his wife and his son. To secure such privileges, it is necessary to file Form BC with the Department of State before the American Consul in Ciaddad, Juarez, Mexico can grant the visas.

At the present time we are short of these forms. I am therefore asking you to have these forms executed by the HIAS and sent from New York to Washington. This will expedite matters. The enclosed form has all the information you will need from this end of the line. The rest will be up to you and mother member of your family, who will, no doubt, be glad to sign to second affidavit. The HIAS will advise you in these matters.

Because your brother and his family are anxious to receive the border crossing cards in order to avail themselves of attending religious services and also business matters, your prompt attention will be appreciated. By way of further information, I understand your brother's wife is illiterate, but since she will apply with him, it will not hinder her securing the visa. The son's wife was born in Mexico and is therefore exempt from these regulations.
