Statement of ANTON SHREMPP, made before Immigrant Inspector Samuel J Perlmutter in the Office of the Inspector in Charge U.S.Immigration Service, Santa Fe Bridge. El Pp Texas, on December 26, 1924.

#### PRESENT:

Samuel J Perlmutter " Anton Schrempp Examining Inspector. Acting German Interpreter. Acting Stenographer The Alien.

### BY THE EXAMINING INSPECTOR TO THE ALIEN:

Q. You are advised that I am an Immigrant Inspector in the employ of the United States Government and desire to take a statement from you regarding your right to be and remain in the United States, which statement, if made by you, should be voluntary on your part and may be used against you in any subsequent proceedings. Are you willing to make such statement under oath? A.Yes.

What is your name? A.Anton Schrempp

- Q. Flease state your age, date of birth, set, conjugal condition, occupation, race, nationality, native town, native province and country, and the nearest large city to your native town. A. 19 1/2 years old., born July 14, 1905., male sex, single, occupation office clerk and assistant salesman, national ity Germany, race German, Hartheim an Rhine, province of Baden, Germany, nearest large city is Freiburg, Baden, Germany.
- Q. State your religion, name and location of church where christened, churches you attended and their location.Roman Catholic, in the Cathedral in Hartheim, Baden Germany. This is the only church I attended until I left Germany.
- Q. Please state names and location of all schools you attended. A. I attended the Fublic School in Hartheim, Freiburg, the High School in Tottmass, Black Forest, Baden and the business school in Freiburg, Baden Germany.
- Q. State your last address in the country in which you last resided. A. I lived in Freiburg, Baden Germany and left from there on my journey to Mexico.
  - Note: Alien informed himselfron states that the American Consul in Stuttgart, Wurttenberg, Germany informed him at the time of his application for an American Consular visa that if he would wait approximately a month he
  - would, he believed, be able to give him a visa. However, friends advised against the dalay and suggested that he go via Mexico as through that count ry he would have a mcu better chance of gaining admission. His intention at the time he left Germany was to gain admission to the United States.
- Q. Please state the name of your FatherA. Anton Schrempp. Where was your Father born A. Schuttertal, Beden, Germany. Where does your Father now live. A. Hartheim an Rhine. Has your Father ever lived in the U.S. Never.
