Dear Mrs. Lazenby:

Re: Ruth Shensul

It was impossible for me to contact the Organization in this case while I was in New York. However, information I received while there prompts me to advise that this case should not be handled in El Paso. We have inadequate housing facilities and with the employment situation such as it is, it would be doing the girl a great injustice to have her come here. Her last trip to Miami seems to have benefited her greatly and feel that the New York Office would be wise in again sending her to that City.

The persons mentioned in the first letter we received on this case were contacted in El Paso. We find that none of them are personally acquainted with Miss Shensul, but because they had suffered from a similar ailment, it seems that their names were on record in the New York Office. All of them are barely making a living in El Paso, and will be unable to in any way assist Miss Shensul.
