Dear Mrs. Zlabovsky:-

We are returning you Debora Kaganoviciate's passport with the necessary extension.

Re: Elisa Sosnowski, we have to advise you, that the Polish Consul has agreed to extend her passport for 3 months. The cost of this will be \$9.50 Dls. He refuses to extend for a longer period because the original passport is Provisional and for 3 months only. Should a longer extension be desired, he would have to write to Poland and inquire why the original passport was Provisional and for 3 months.

Re: Mrs. Rotenberg, we can advise that the extension of this passport will cost \$12.50 Dls.




Dear Mrs. Zlabovsky:-


