Dr. Polachek and his family are now dependent on this community. He wants to go to Mexice City. We have learned that our San Diego section spent \$300.00 on him last year. Can you give us a report on this case? In all possibilities, the El Paso section has been interested since this man has evidently been in touch with all the agencies along the way.
