In El Paso the orthodox Rabbi gave Dr. Polachek a letter to the Hias of New York suggesting that the Hias would furnish him with a ticket for himself and family to return to the Argentine, which he claims is his native land. Dr. Polachek and his family are now dependent on this community. He wants to go to Mexice City. We have learned that our San Diego section spent \$300.00 on him last year. Can you give us a report on this case? In all possibilities, the El Paso section has been interested since this man has evidently been in touch with all the agencies along the way.
