If you should decide to come, we are always glad to help those who come and ask our assistance morally; financially our Department is depleted.

You have much to be thankful for, that you and your children are enjoying good health, and am sure that after the shock of your loss is somewhat modified, you will be able to pick up the threads where your husband left off, finding some means of making a living.

You failed to answer the letter I wrote to you during your stay in Chicago, which was quite unfair to this Organization, and the doctors in El Paso, who did so much for you, also when I appealed to your husband before he left Juarez, knowing that he had considerable money, he refused to leave even the sum of \$10.00 for each of the doctors. Perhaps we would not have been so persistent, but you always boasted that you had plenty.
