SUBJECT Isaac Borisovich Leplin

You will be pleased to learn that at last we succeeded in inducing the brother to take some definite action with regard to the above named. Mr. Leplin called at Ellis Island at our request and there he was informed by the Law Division that he should communicate with the Immigration officials at El Paso, advising them to authorize Ellis Island officials to arrange for the placing of the \$500 bond in the case of our client. Will you immediately take this up with the Immigration officials and find out if they have heard from Mr. Leplin to this effect. If not, will you ask the Immigration officials to authorize the Law Division at Ellis Island to accept the bond, advising us that you have done so, so that we may again take the matter up with Mr. Leplin and bring it to a successful conclusion.
