Cecilia Razovsky Secretary and **Executive Director**  In answer to your letter regarding Dr. Ernest Rosenfeld, or Dr. Ernest Romer, age 44, who lives in Vienna and wishes to come to the United States, I should say the only way in which he can do that is if his brother in Mexico City will deposit a large sum of money to his credit here in the United States, and then will send affidavits to the Consul guaranteeing that he will support the family until such time as the brother is self-supporting.

What do you think of my suggestion that Dr. Ernest Rosenfeld go to Cuba and let his brother, Hans Rosen, from Mexico City meet him there and go to the American Consul and see if he can get him a visa for the States.

There is nothing we can do from here, as he must have affidavits of support, as you know, or a large bank account before the American Consul in Vienna will grant him a visa.
