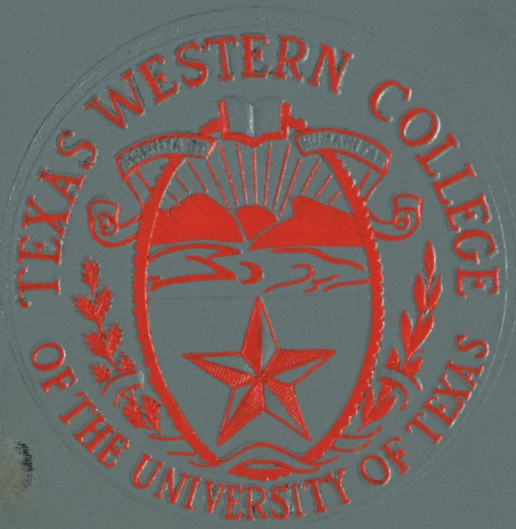

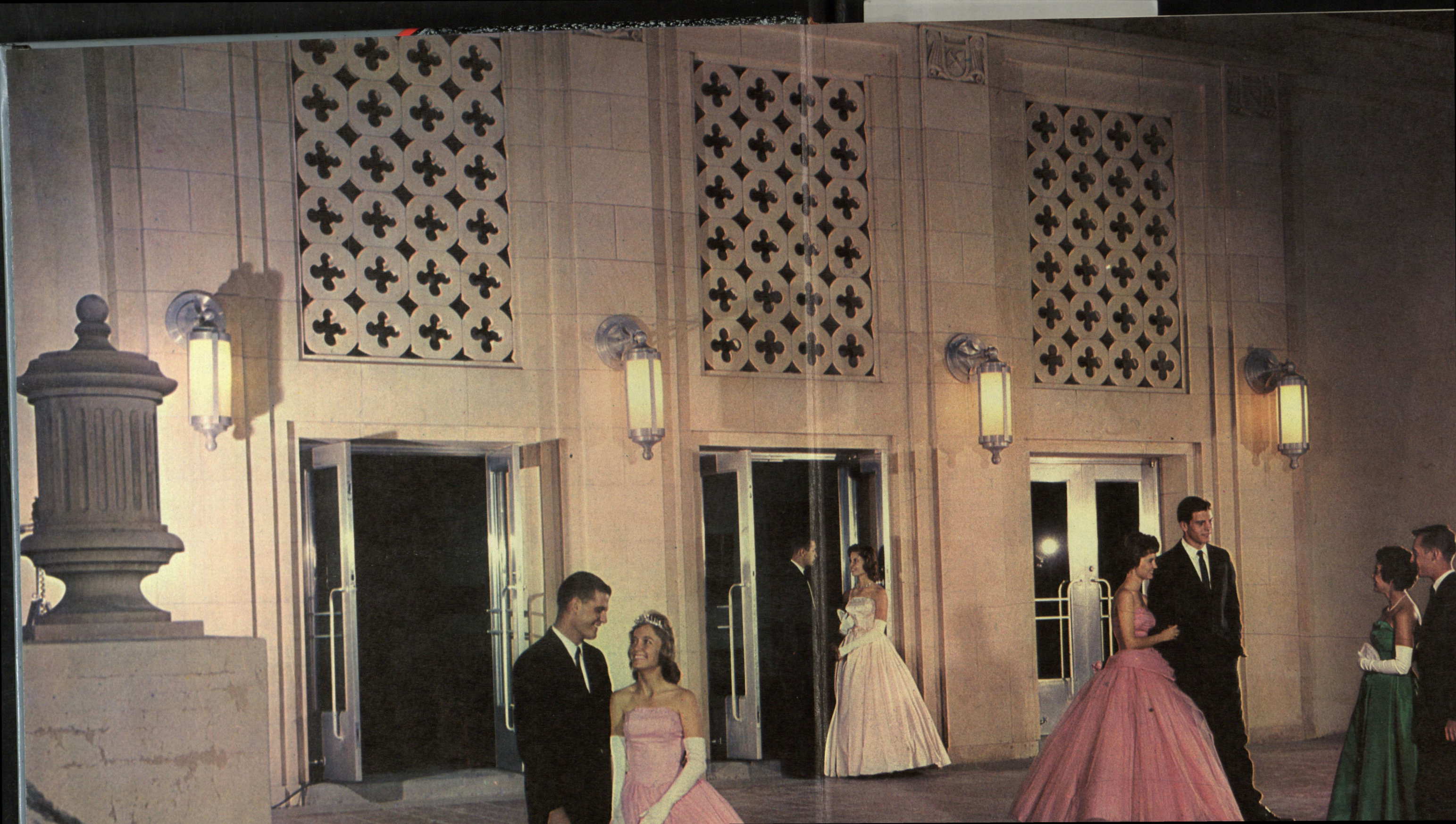

HE talks of history, and his students listen and learn.

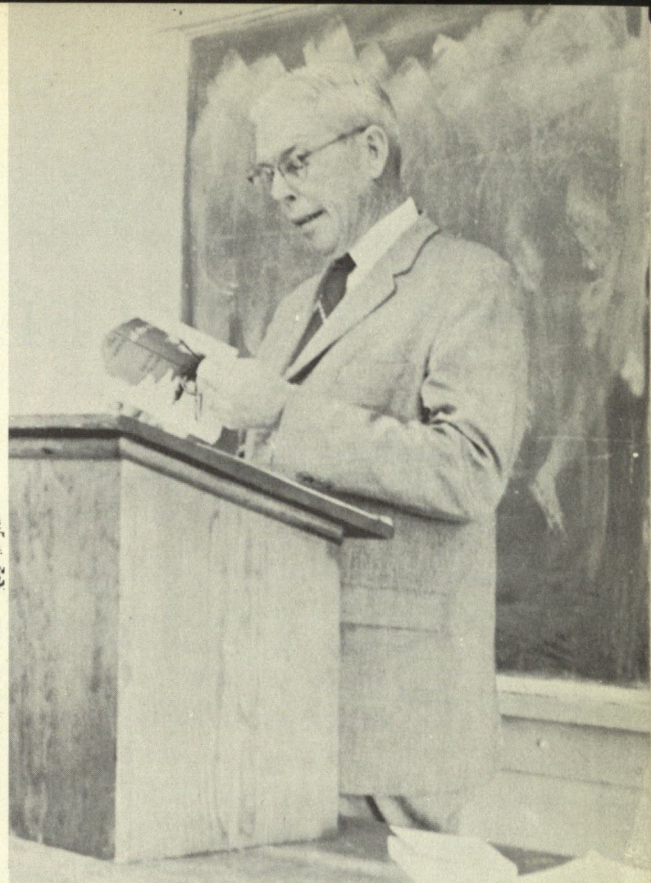
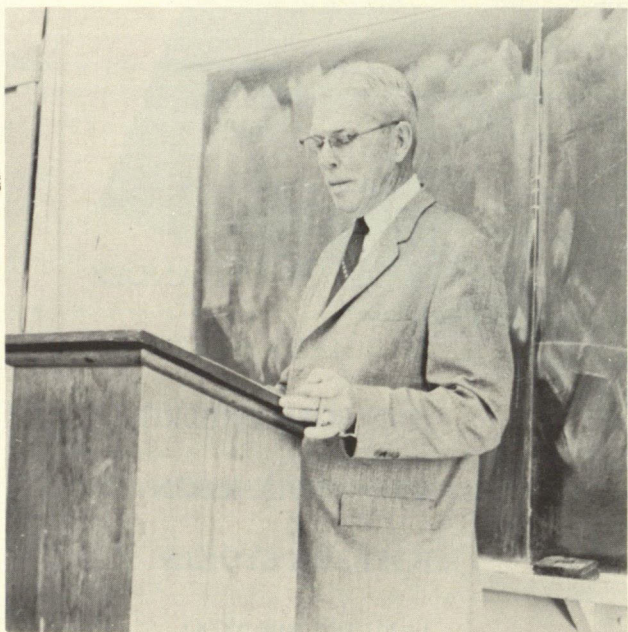
HE lectures, but he also listens. In his classes there are many questions always answered, and debates.

HE brings alive Clio, the Muse of History.

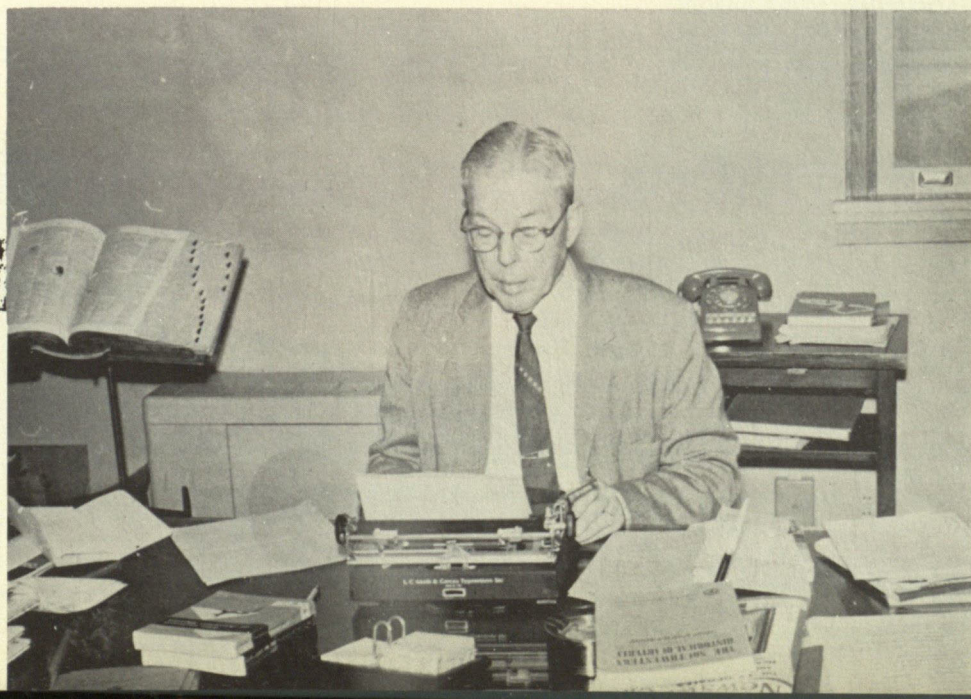

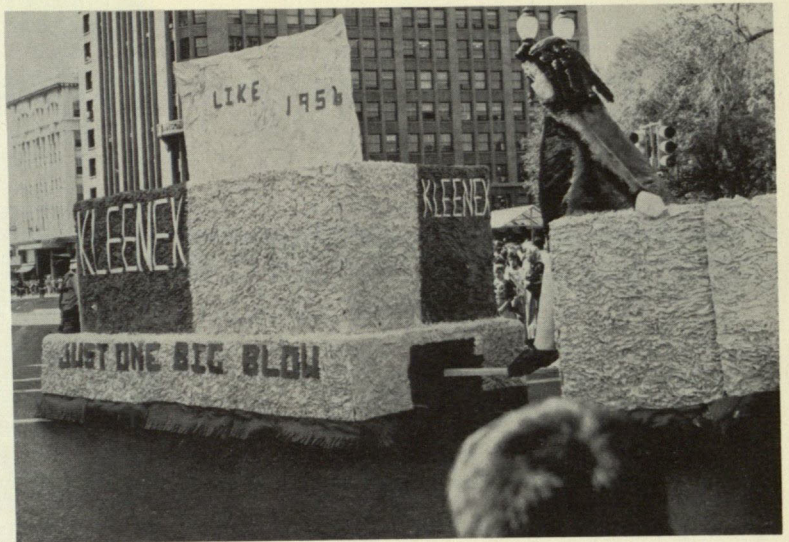

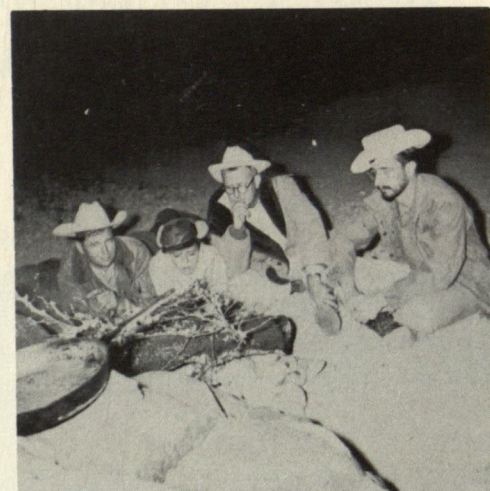
NEW GROUP ON CAMPUS THE "DESERT RATS"

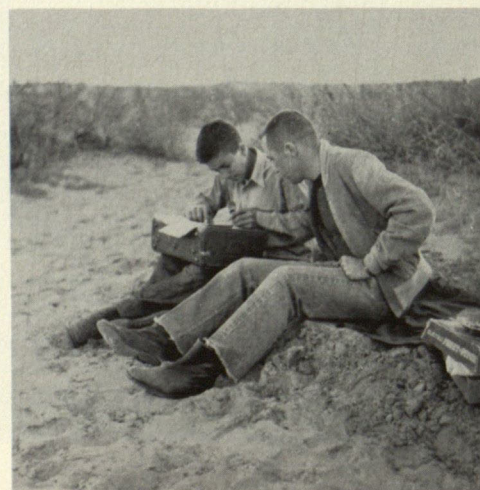

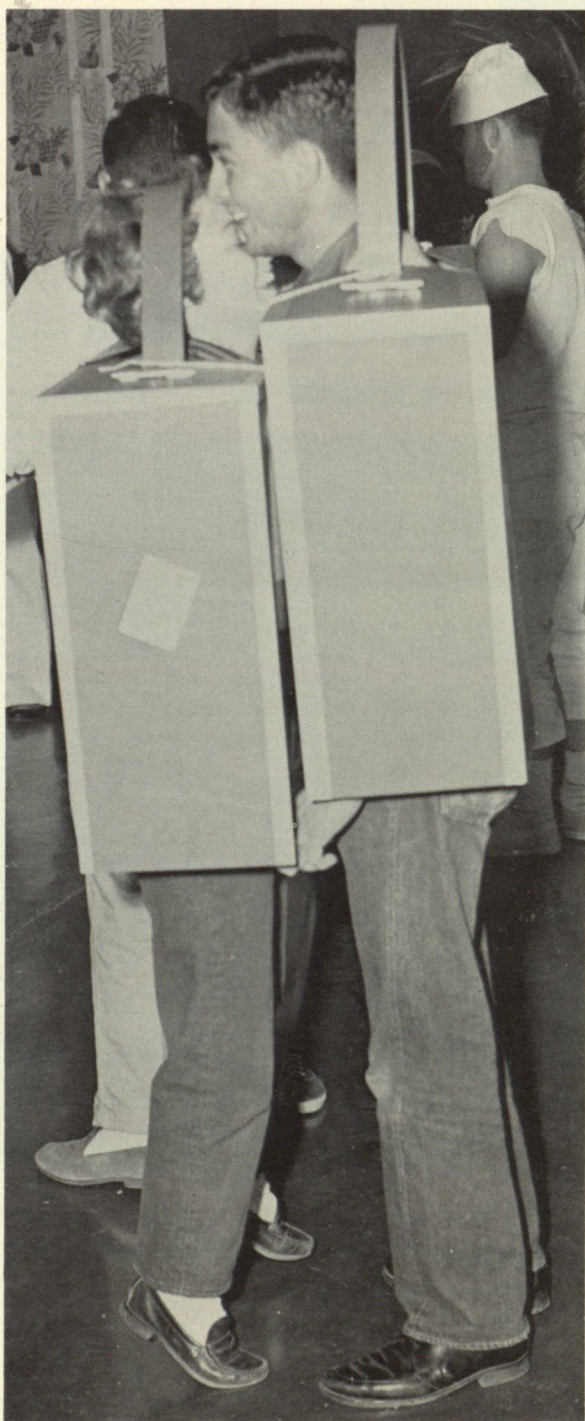

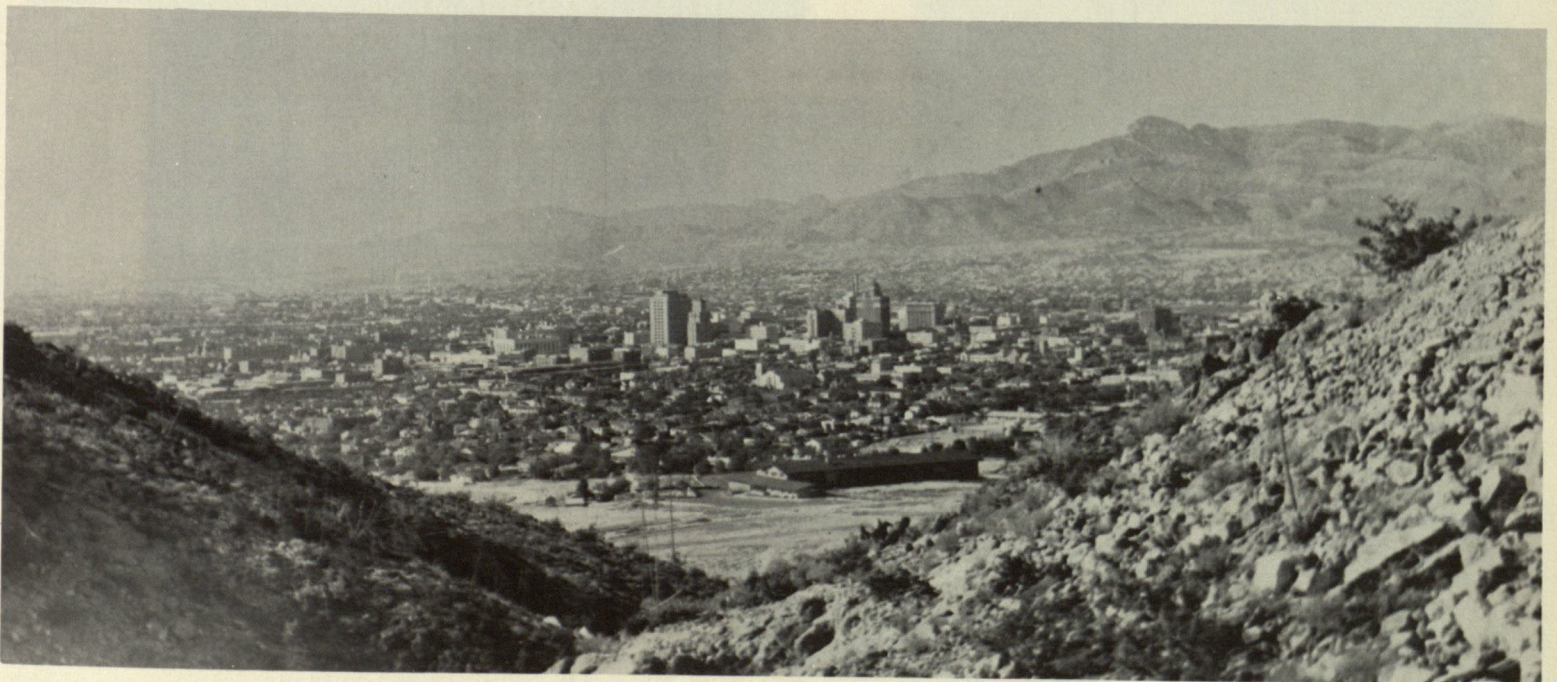

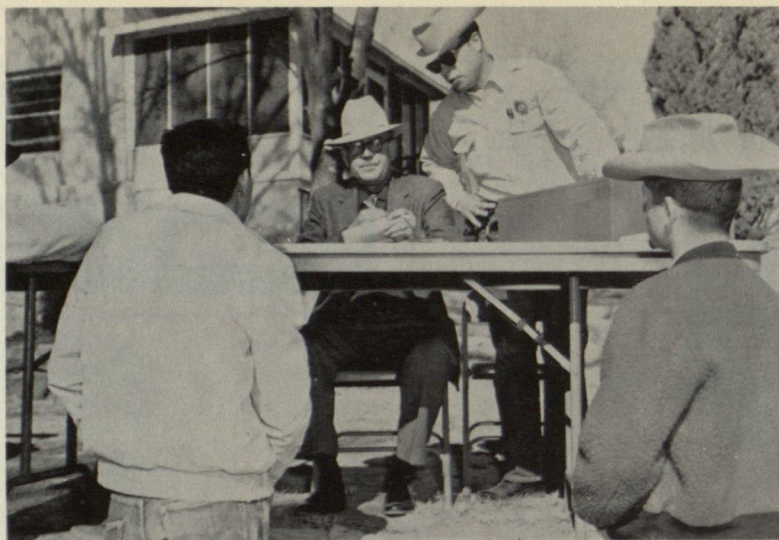

Other participants in this all-American contest were Salvador Ramos, Herb Bell, Dave Short Jr., Lloyd Adams and Henry Morales.

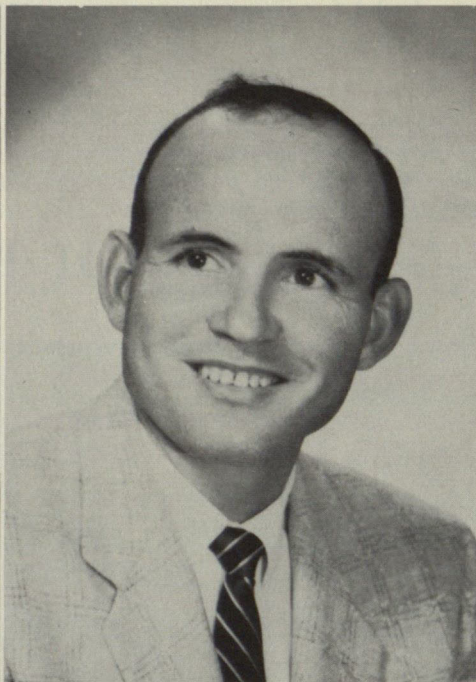
