I, Edwin Wisbrun, residing at 519 Hague Street, El Paso, Texas, being duly sworn, depose and say:

That I am 62 years of age, and am a naturalized citizen of the United States since 1914.

That I am in the mercantile business in El Paso, Texas and Juarez, Mexico, and that my estate free and unincumbered is not less than One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00).

That my income exceeds Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) annually, and that my only dependent is my wife, Beata D. Wisbrun.

That it is my desire and intention to have the following relatives, who are my first cousins, now residing at 240 Route Vallon, 20 Astrid Apartments, Shanghai, China, to come and remain with us in the United States:

Richard Detlev Loewenberg, M.D., born June 18, 1898,

Sophie L. Borowicz Loewenberg, wife, born Feb. 26, 1903,

Peter L. Loewenberg, son, born August 14, 1933, all of whom were born in Hamburg, Germany.

That I do hereby promise, agree and guarantee that I will properly receive and take care of the aforementioned aliens, and that I will at no time allow them to become public charges on any community or municipality of the United States; that I am fully able to care for the aliens and am perfectly willing to do so.

That this affidavit is made by me individually in order that our American Consul Abroad will visa the passports of Dr. and Mrs. Loewenberg and Son, and the Immigration authorities to admit said aliens into the United States.
