We wish to inform you that your brother above mentioned is ill and in financial distress. Our Organization has been called and we have given emergency relief in the sum of \$5.00, also medical care.

Will you please assist Mr. Maislin? We will be glad to see that any money sent through our Organization reaches him and to give him whatever other assistance he may need. At our suggestion, he has received food and care in our Juarez, Mexican Yiddish colony. These people must be paid for their services, and would appreciate your reimbursing us for expenditures already incurred.
