Dear Miss Razovsky:-

I have discussed the case of Mrs. Mata with Mrs. Mayer, and upon her arrival, I will be better prepared to suggest a way out of her difficulties. I still think that my original suggestion for someone to accompany her to Mexico is better than her husband coming to the Border to meet her. Mrs. Mayer would be glad to take the trip and handle her case in diplomatic manner. The expense attached to that would not exceed \$150.00, besides Mrs. Mata's own expense. It may be necessary to step outside of the Mexican laws, but it can be done.

While Mrs. Mayer is in Mexico City (if she goes) it would be an excellent opportunity for her to organize a Council since the Jewish Women in that City are anxious for outside affiliation. Will advise you further.
