Ruseian third class arrived in New York before Tishabov in June or July 1907.

Jonah Segal (Yankel Milicovsky) was born in Vilna Poland about

Oct. 2, 1889. He claims to have an Uncle K. Michalov who used to have a grocery store
at 310 Henry street New York.

On same vessel were Rubin Levin with Mother Mrs. Levin and sistr Revka (Rebecca) Levin. also travelling third class.
