Dear Sir:

We have located Espera Israel in Panuco, State of Vera Cruz, Mexico. This place is 1300 miles from this border and it was necessary to communicate with Mexico City and through this agency we succeeded in getting aid to her.

Our communication with Mexico City revealed that she is awaiting mail from relatives in the United States.

If you should communicate with her relatives please acquaint them with the fact that the place where she is located is a very unhealthy section of the country and since she is so near to Tampico we would suggest that she return to her own country.

We find that girls alone in Mexico are subject to many temptations and thru poverty are lead astray. For this reason we stress that she would be far better off with her own people.

If we can serve you further in this case kindly let us know.
