## Biographical Sketch

Dr. John “Jack” Herbert Haddox (1929-2017) received his PhD from Notre Dame and joined the UTEP (then Texas Western College) faculty in 1957. He taught courses in philosophy, history, ethics, logic, and the humanities. In 1962 Dr. Haddox was named chair of the Philosophy Department at UTEP. He established his reputation as an authority on Latin American philosophy by writing several books about Mexican thought and philosophers. His books include *José Vasconcelos: Mexican Philosopher* and *Wings and Lead: The Philosophy of Antonio Caso*. He also wrote numerous scholarly articles about border life and minorities which were published in philosophical journals. During his long career, Dr. Haddox received many awards, such as the Faculty Research Award in 1979. He also organized trips to Mexico for students and others interested in Mexican culture. In addition to his regular teaching and research activities, he mentored and educated students at the Catholic Campus Ministry. He often presented at brown bag discussions for UTEP students and was a member of many organizations, such as the American Philosophical Association. John Haddox was a beloved activist and educator. He is remembered by faculty and students for his humanity. In recognition of his long career at UTEP, Dr. Haddox was honored by the university for over fifty years of service.

## Scope and Content Notes

The John H. Haddox papers, MS516, date from 1955 to 2006. The collection contains teaching materials, subject files, pamphlets, publications, correspondence, class notes, and other items. The papers mostly relate to Dr. Haddox's research interests and teaching career at UTEP.

## Provenance Statement

Dr. Haddox donated some of his articles and monographs on his retirement. Jon Amastae donated some correspondence and pamphlets in June 2007. A C.V., note, and publication were sent by mail to Special Collections and arrived on April 21, 2017. Madeline Haddox (daughter of Dr. John Haddox ) donated five boxes of her father's papers in November 2017 which were picked up at his office in the Philosophy Department.
