Biography

Born in El Paso, Elliot Chess (d. 1962) was a decorated military pilot. He left El Paso High School and joined the Royal Flying Corps in Canada; he went overseas to fight in WWI at age 18. During the Polish-Soviet War (1919 – 1921), he flew for the Polish air force as part of the Kościuszko squadron. His cousin, Earl Evans, also was a WWI pilot and volunteer in the Kościuszko squadron. For his bravery, Chess received Poland's highest military honor, the *Virtuti Militari*. He later worked for the *El Paso Times* as an ad manager and was also a miner, reporter, editor, professional wrestler, playwright, and author.

Series Description or Arrangement

The papers were left in the order found by the archivist.

Scope and Content Notes

The Elliot Chess papers, MS238, date circa 1910s – 1959. Types of records include correspondence, military orders and service documentation, literary manuscripts and notes, photos, clippings, medals, and artwork. These materials help document Chess's family life, military career, and writing activities.
