Biography

Dr. Eugene O. Porter was an Assistant Professor of History at the University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP). He was born in Bridgeport, Ohio in 1899, and first came to El Paso in September of 1940. He earned his doctorate degree at Ohio State in 1939. He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1943 to 1951. During his academic career he wrote hundreds of scholarly papers on different history-related topics – especially the U.S. Civil War and Latin American History. He also published two books: *The Fallacies of Karl Marx* and *Lord Beresford and Lady Flo*. Porter was the editor of *Password*, the publication of the El Paso County Historical Society.

The collection was left in the same order it was found by the archivist.

Scope and Content Notes

The Eugene O. Porter papers, MS483, date 1858-1973. Types of records include photographs, correspondence, scrapbooks, college lectures notes, research notes, journals, and other materials. The papers help document Porter's research interests, academic career, and family.
