Biographical Sketch

Jack Caruthers Vowell, a professor, business owner, and politician, was born on May 9, 1927 in El Paso, Texas. Educated in the El Paso public schools, he attended Georgetown University, Texas Western College (now UTEP), and Harvard University. He received a B.S. and a M.S. in Foreign Service from Georgetown; an M.A. in History from UTEP; and studied Advanced Studies in History and American Civilization at Harvard. Vowell was on active military service from 1945-1946.

Vowell worked at Georgetown University (1948-1950) and at the University of Texas at El Paso (1955-1962). He worked as Administrative Vice-President, Executive Vice-President, and President and Chairman of the Board at Vowell Construction Company from 1955 to 1973.

Vowell's career as a politician started in 1981. He served in the Texas House of Representatives from 1981 – 1995. He was the first El Paso Republican elected to a full term in the Texas Legislature since 1876. He was also the first politician from El Paso appointed to serve on the Texas Sunset Advisory Commission and the only Republican to serve as its Chair. Vowell was named one of the best legislators in *Best and Worst Legislators* for 1985, 1987, and 1991. He was the author of House Bill 7, 72nd Legislature, which resulted in total restructuring of 11 Health and Human Services agencies into a single coordinated system.

Vowell also received the following awards: El Gran Paseño Award, Unite El Paso Appreciation Award, Sunturians of El Paso Medal of Merit, Rotary Club of El Paso Distinguished Service Award, and the Texas for Children Support for Needy Children Award.

Vowell died on August 29, 2006.

The Jack Vowell papers are contained in 35 boxes. They were left in original order as found by the archivist.

Scope and Content Notes

The Jack Vowell papers date from 1986 to 1994, bulk 1991 to 1993. The papers were left in original order, which is primarily alphabetic order. The papers contain information about Vowell's political career and activities. Types of records include proposed bills, press releases, speeches, bill copies, case records, program data, thank you letters and responses, newspaper clippings, and studies and data regarding bills from the 68th to 73rd Texas House of Representatives.
