Historical Sketch

The Paso del Norte Solidarity Committee formed in the mid-1990s in response to actions by the Mexican military against indigenous communities in southern Mexico, particularly in Chiapas, Mexico. During this time, the Ejército Zapatista de Liberación Nacional (EZLN) sought sovereignty from the Mexican state and intervened in the Chiapas region. The EZLN rejected the National Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) between Mexico and the U.S.

Formed by local workers, women, students, religious personnel, and community activists, the El Paso del Norte Solidarity Committee cultivated a learning community that studied this economic, political, and social crisis in Mexico and its impact on U.S.-Mexico relations, as well as to daily life. The Committee supported movements that strengthened democracy both in Mexico and in the United States.

Scope and Content Notes

The Paso del Norte Solidarity Committee records primarily date 1994-1996. The records help document the Committee's activities and events in Chiapas. They contain correspondence, photographs, pamphlets, newspaper clippings, and articles. The records also include accounts and correspondence of members and affiliated members that served as human rights observers in Chiapas between 1995 and 1996. Additionally, the records contain 16 VHS tapes and 2 audiocassettes in possibly poor condition.
