## **Biography**

Dr. Julius Rivera (1917 – 2014) was a Professor Emeritus of Sociology and Anthropology at the University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP). Born in Colombia, Dr. Rivera received a Fulbright Scholarship to study in Chile and studied Latin America and the U.S.-Mexico border from a sociological perspective during his long career. His publications include: *Latin America: A Sociocultural Interpretation*, *On Chicano Studies*, and *Poemas y Evocación*. After his retirement from teaching at UTEP, Dr. Rivera helped establish the Center for Lifelong Learning (now the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute) on campus. He was married to Linda Gerstenberger Rivera and had three children.
