Biography

Richard (Dick) W. Tripp, Jr. is a former naval officer and has a PhD in physics from the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterrey, California. He is also a travel writer and co-authored a book, *Food and Drink in Argentina: A Guide for Residents and Tourists*. Born in Washington, North Carolina, Tripp graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1962. He received his PhD in 1971. In 1988, he retired as a Captain from the U.S. Navy. Tripp married Marshall Carter-Tripp in October 1983. They lived in Virginia, Brussels, Madrid, and Buenos Aires for Carter-Tripp's work. They currently live in El Paso, Texas.

Marshall Carter-Tripp is former political science professor, diplomat, and museum director. She served in the U.S. Foreign Service, where she specialized in international security affairs, human rights, and science and the environment. Carter-Tripp became the director of the Centennial Museum at UTEP in 2006. She held that position until her retirement in 2010. During her directorship, Carter-Tripp also served as president of the Border Museum Association.
