## **Biographical Sketch**

Richard Clifton (Cliff) Hagerty (August 21, 1932 - May 30, 2017) was a military veteran and railroad enthusiast. He was married to Martha Fierro Hagerty for 62 years. The railroad collection that he donated to the University of Texas at El Paso Library consists primarily of material relating to the El Paso & Southwestern (E. P. & S. W.) and associated railroads.

## **Arrangement**

The collection is largely in original order, and preserves Hagerty's original folder titles. Correspondence in box 3, folders 1 and 2, was moved from box 1, and oversized material was separated. The photographs in box 4, folder 1, are in original order. Photographs in box 1, folder 2, are organized according to the Wythe classification system for engines, which classifies engines according to the number and location of wheels on a locomotive. The first number of the system denotes the number of wheels leading the powered wheels or drivers; the last number indicates the number of wheels trailing the powered wheels. Numbers are separated by a dash. Photographs in folder 2, box 1, are divided into three categories: cars, trains, and locomotives. Locomotives are further separated by type, based on a wheelbase in standard use in 1924.

## **Scope and Content Notes**

The Richard C. Hagerty railroad collection dates 1882– 1982, bulk 1915 – 1965. Types of records include correspondence, research notes, photographs, blueprints, maps, charts, publications, and artifacts documenting the history of El Paso and Southwestern Railroad, its locomotives, train cars, and railroad infrastructure in the El Paso area. The collection consists of research material for a book Hagerty and Robert Kuykendall were writing on the motive power of the E.P. & S.W.

## **Provenance Statement**

The collection was donated to the University of Texas at El Paso Library by Richard C. Hagerty in 1993. Donor acquired material through trade or purchase from various sources.
