Biography

Dr. Kathleen Staudt (born 1946) is a former University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) professor and a prolific researcher and writer about social and political issues on the U.S. -Mexico border. She received her PhD from the University of Wisconsin - Madison in 1976 and joined the faculty at UTEP in 1977. She coordinated the Women's Studies program at UTEP during the early 1980s. In 1998, she founded the UTEP Center for Civic Engagement and directed it for ten years. She was awarded the prestigious Border Hero Award for Service in 2011.
