## **Historical Sketch**

Colonel Forrest L. Martz was a military veteran and teacher who fought in WWI, WWII, and the Korean War. He began his military career fighting in France and in Belgium during WWI. He served in the Caribbean and Germany during WWII and participated in the Dachau trails. Martz then served in the First Division for The Republic of Korea during the Korean War. He received 13 decorations during his career, including the Distinguished Service Cross. After 32 years of service, Martz retired and taught math and social studies at the University of Cambridge in Cambridge, Massachusetts for the next three years. Later, he taught for nine years in the El Paso public school system. In 1970, he took a teaching position at Radford School for Girls, here in El Paso. He was also a board director and lifetime member of the Camp Fire Girls. On July 26, 1978, he passed away in San Antonio. His friends, family, and the Camp Fire Council held a memorial for him at Fort Bliss on August 5, 1978.
