Historical Sketch

Ho Baron is an American sculptor known for surrealist figures. He was born in 1941 in Chicago, Illinois, but was raised in El Paso, Texas. He served in the Peace Corps and became interested in African Art while living in Ethiopia and Nigeria. In 1970, Baron moved to Belgium and worked as a photographer. During the late 1970s, he moved back to El Paso. Baron earned a BA and a MA in English and a master's degree in Library science. In addition to his art career, Baron worked as a community college librarian in El Paso, authored two books, and published a satirical newspaper – the *El Paso Lampoon*.

Baron began sculpting in 1979 and has created over 200 works during his career. Many of his works are available to view for free in "Ho's Sculpture Garden", which is located at 2830 Aurora in El Paso. Baron is most famous for his collection of Bronze humanoid figures known as "Gods for Future Religions".
