## **Historical Sketch**

Established in 1981 by William Mayfield, the El Paso Native Plant Society researches "native plant identification, ecology, and uses; encourages preservation of natural habitats; supports botanical research; and promotes use of native plants for conservation of water, land, and wildlife." Past presidents include Jalaire Craver, Keith Rihn, Virginia Kemendo, Joan Miller, and Charles Galt. The Society joined the Franklin Mountains Wilderness Coalition in 1986 and has participated in several public outreach activities over the years. The Society later became the El Paso chapter of the Native Plant Society of New Mexico.
