Historical Sketch

C.H. Cooper was a lumber mill manager in Mexico from 1911 to 1950. He originally managed the Pearson mill in northern Chihuahua and later the El Salto mill in Durango starting in 1929. During his time in Mexico, he faced multiple attempts on his life and encountered several figures of the Mexican Revolution. C.H. Cooper had two sons: Clarence and Herbert who were both born in El Salto, Durango.

Dr. Clarence "Kiki" Cooper is a retired physics professor at the University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP). He received his PhD from the University of Texas at Austin and taught at UTEP from 1960 – 2013. Kiki Cooper also started La Viña Winery in New Mexico in 1977 and performs Mexican folk music.

The Cooper family papers, MS673, document the career and family of C.H. Cooper as well as lumber mills in Chihuahua and Durango and the Mexican Revolution. The papers date circa 1900s – 2001, bulk dates, circa 1900s – 1950s. Types of materials include photographs, clippings, and correspondence. The papers were left in original order.
