Biography

Dorothea Magdalena Fox (1904 – 1999) was a librarian and travel writer. Born in La Crosse, Wisconsin, Fox graduated from La Crosse State Teachers in 1929 and then attended library school at the University of Minnesota. Fox's first professional librarian position was at the Cedar Rapids Public Library in 1930.

In 1938, Fox was inspired to travel to Europe after reading *How to Travel Without Being Rich* by William McCreery Strong. Along with 25 Americans, Fox traveled through Europe on a bicycle and stayed in inexpensive youth hostels. After her return to the U.S., Fox decided to travel around Wisconsin and Iowa via bicycle. She recounted her journey in her book *Pedalling to Adventure*.

Fox later moved to Indiana and then to El Paso for librarian positions. She was briefly married in 1942 to her childhood friend Miles Graves in Arizona, but kept her job in Indiana. In December 1949, Fox was appointed head librarian of Biggs Air Force Base in El Paso. She became interested in researching local history while in El Paso.
