## **Biography or Historical Sketch**

Joseph Friedkin was born in Brooklyn in 1908 and moved with his family to El Paso at the age of six. He attended school in El Paso and graduated from the Texas School of Mines in 1932.

Joseph Friedkin had a successful academic career at the Texas School of Mines (now UTEP) where he pursued. He was on the honor roll every semester that he attended the Texas School of Mines and served as the President of the Student Association from 1931 to 1932, Vice President of the Student Association from 1930 to 1931, participated in Band from 1928-1929, serving as band manager from 1931-1932. In addition to his academic and extracurricular success, Friedkin saw success in sports playing Basketball from 1928 -1931 (Captain in 1930) and Tennis from 1928-1929 (Captain in 1930, winner of the College Tennis Tournament in 1931).

After graduating, Joseph Friedkin worked as a Civil Engineer with the International Boundary and Water Commission (IBWC) except for the time he served in the military during World War II until his retirement in 1986. He started at the IBWC Hydraulic Engineer conducting field studies on irrigation water used in Mexico as supplied by the Colorado River. This work was later used as the basis for allotment acreages in the 1944 Water Treaty between the United States and Mexico.

During World War II Joseph Friedkin entered the Army in 1942 as a 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant; Mr. Friedkin worked at the Vicksburg Office of the Army's Corp of Engineers facility performing analytical work and managing projects that stabilized the Lower Mississippi river. He was discharged as a Major in 1946.

Upon returning to El Paso after the war he was assigned the task of planning and supervising implementation of the 1944 Water Treaty. In 1962 Mr. Friedkin was appointed to the position of Commissioner of the International Boundary and Water Commission by President Kennedy. As the Commissioner of the IBWC Mr. Friedkin was the driving force behind the successful settlement of the Chamizal Issue, solving the salinity problem of the Lower Colorado River (to the satisfaction of both Mexico and the United States). In addition, he was instrumental in guiding the IBWC through issues such as the Tijuana Flood Control and Sewage Treatment Problem, the Nogales Sewage Treatment problem, and the Lower Rio Grande Flood Control Problem. After the resolution of the Chamizal Issue President Lyndon B. Johnson raised his position from Commissioner to Ambassador.

Mr. Friedkin retired from the IBWC in 1986. He passed away in 2008 at the age of 98.

## **Series Description or Arrangement**

The Friedkin Papers are kept mainly in their original order. In order to facilitate the use of the collection by researchers, collection materials have been placed into archival quality acid-free folders. These folders have been titled with the original folder titles or report names as they were available on original folders. Where original folder titles did

not exist, UTEP Special Collections staff have titled folders based on the subject or material type of the documents they hold. Folders titled by staff are indicated with the titles being held in brackets (Ex. [Folder Title])

The Friedkin collection consists of Eleven (11) total boxes. Eight (8) (Boxes 1-8) of these are standard Hollinger Record Boxes, one (1) (Box 9) is a Legal sized Hollinger document box, and two (2) (Boxes 10-11) are Hollinger Oversized boxes.

There are no damage or preservation concerns at this time.

## **Scope and Content Notes**

This collection contains materials pertaining to Joseph Friedkin's career working with the International Boundary and water Commission.

Of particular importance (and prevalence within the collection) are materials relating to the research, negotiations, and arrangements of the Chamizal Issue.

Other large portions of the collection are dedicated to the Salinity of the Colorado River (Colorado River Basin), and flood control in the Lower Rio Grande Valley of Texas.

Material types in this collection include Maps, Charts, Documents, Manuscripts, Notes, Reports, Government Reports, Photographs, and Memorabilia

Notes found in the collection inventory have been adapted from an incomplete preliminary inventory.
