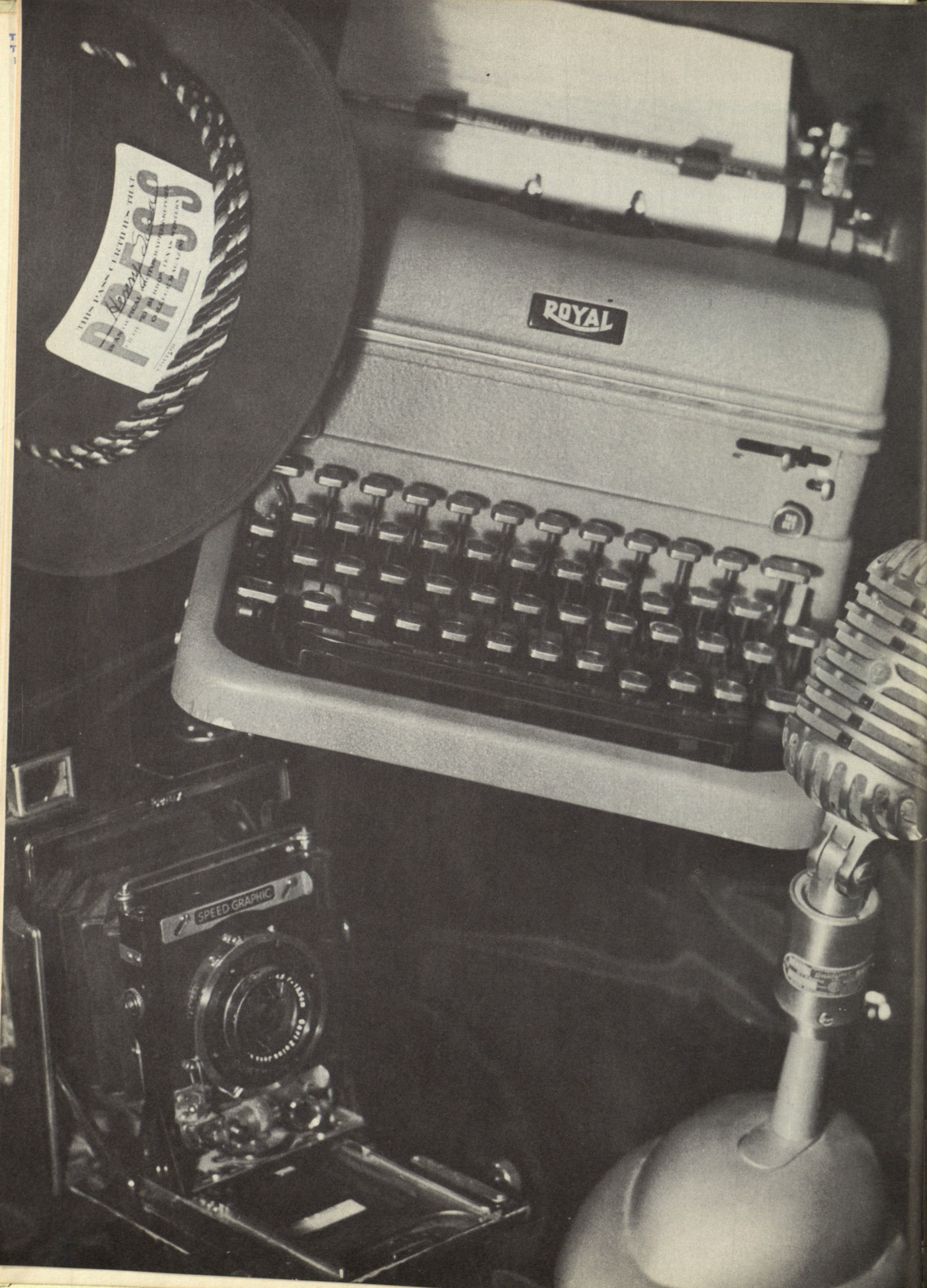


61 YEARS OF COMBINED SERVICE TO TEXAS WESTERN COLLEGE

A trophy is given to the winning team. The team which has the most points at the end of the year receives the All Intra-mural Trophy.

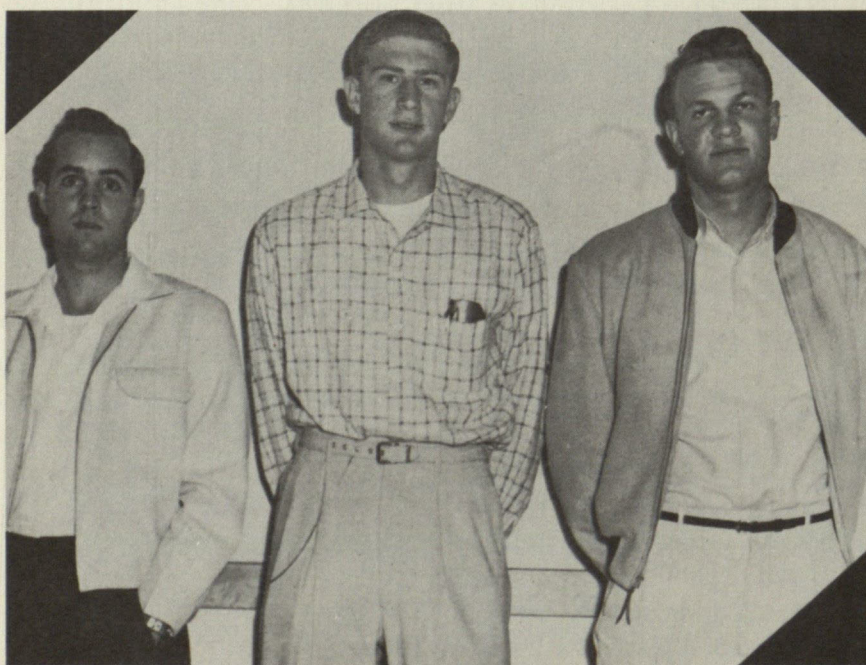
