These are the capacities in which Eugene M. Thomas has served Texas Western for 30 years.

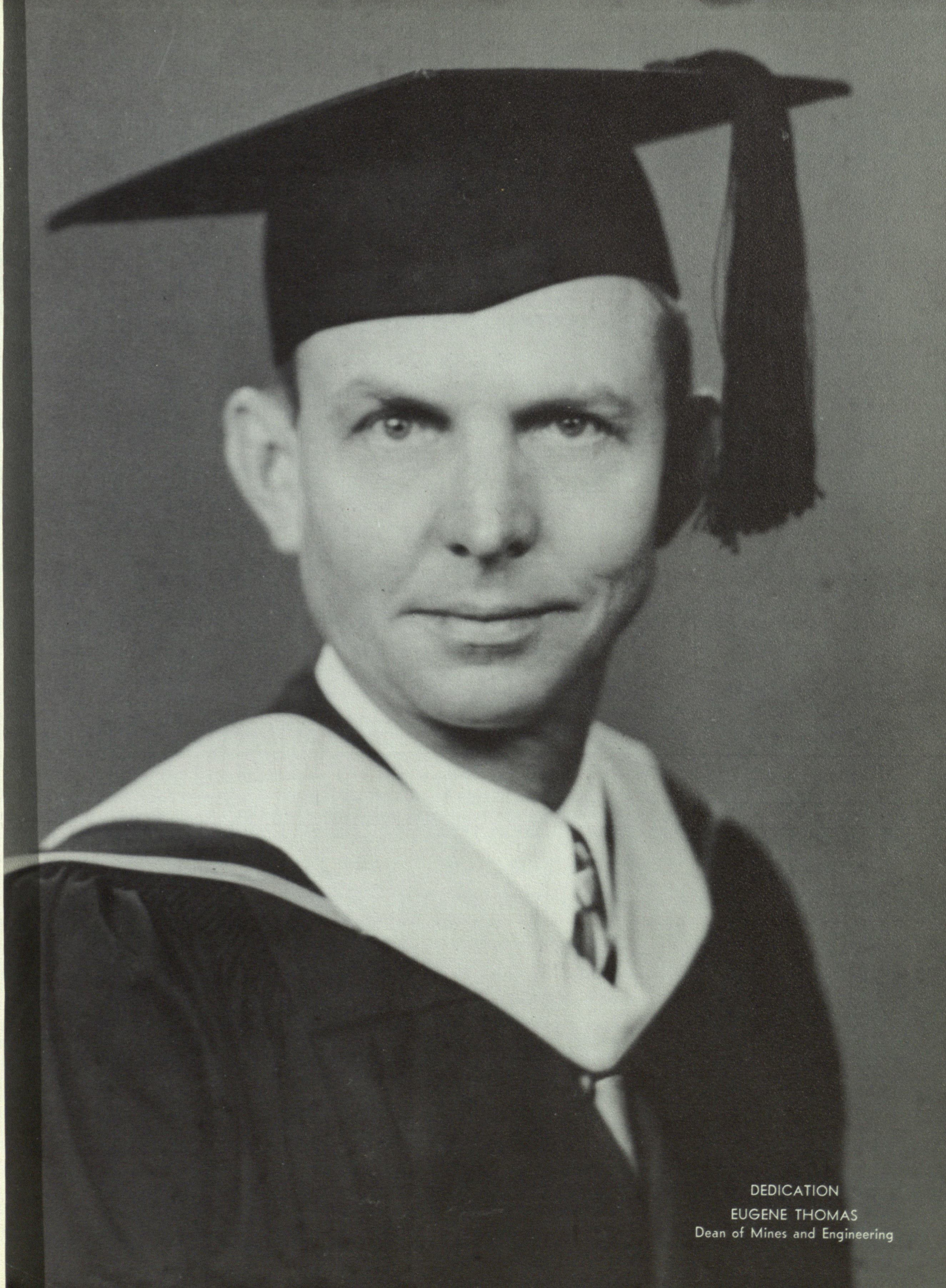
He graduated from the old Texas College of Mines in 1926 with a Bachelor of Science in mining engineering and joined the faculty here in 1930. He has taught mining, engineering and metallurgy here ever since, except for time out to do graduate work.

He received a Master of Science in metallurgy from Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1939 and the Engineer of Mines degree from TCM in 1940.

He became Dean of Engineering in 1942, and has served the College and the Engineering Department well, turning out engineers and helping the College become one of the leading engineering schools in the country.

Dean Thomas was acting president of the College for three months in 1948. He is a registered engineer and has worked in the industries of the growing Southwest.
