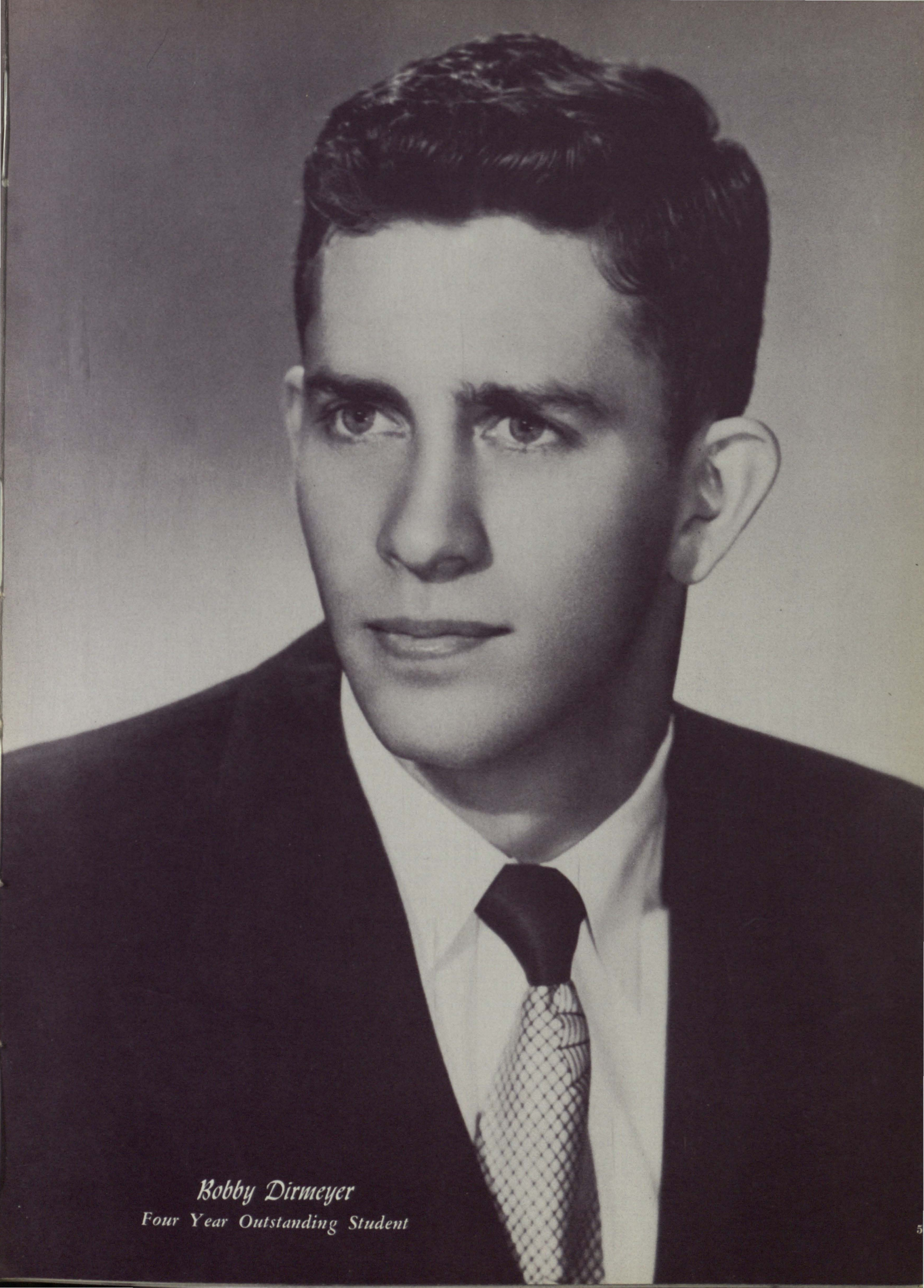

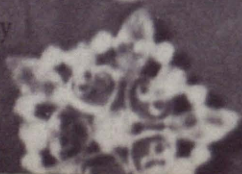

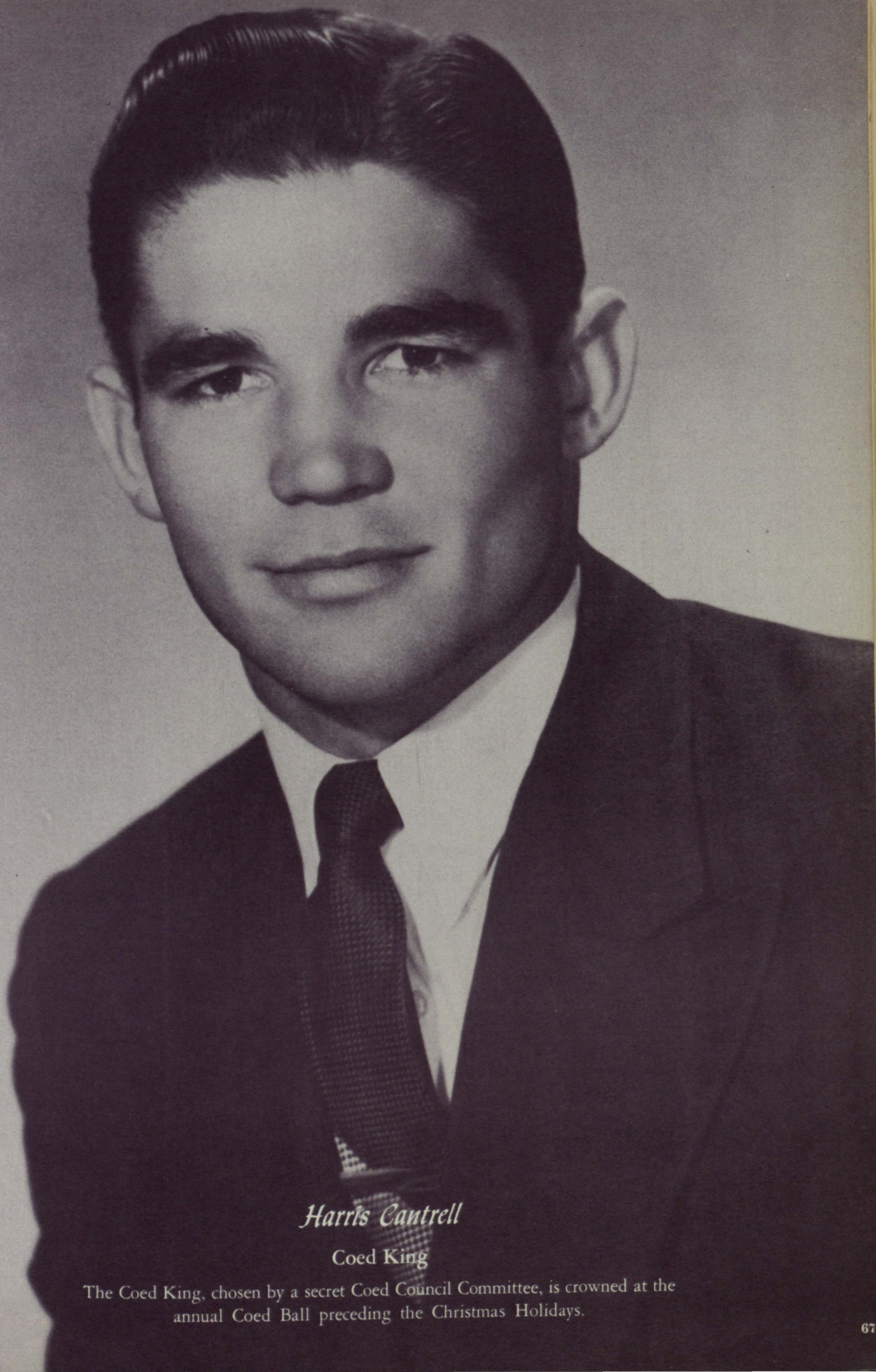
The Summer School Queen is chosen in a beauty contest and is crowned at the annual summer school dance.
