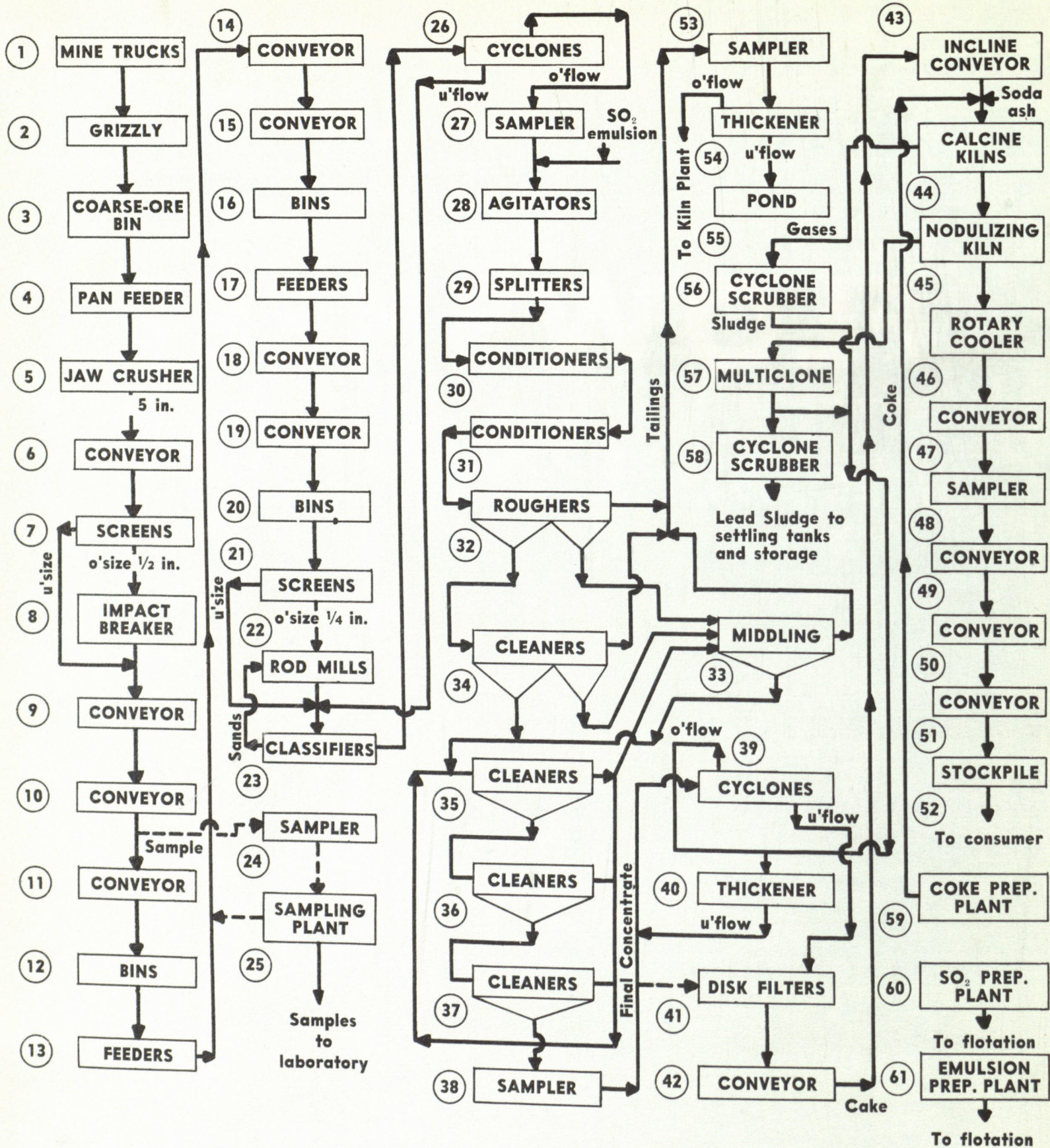

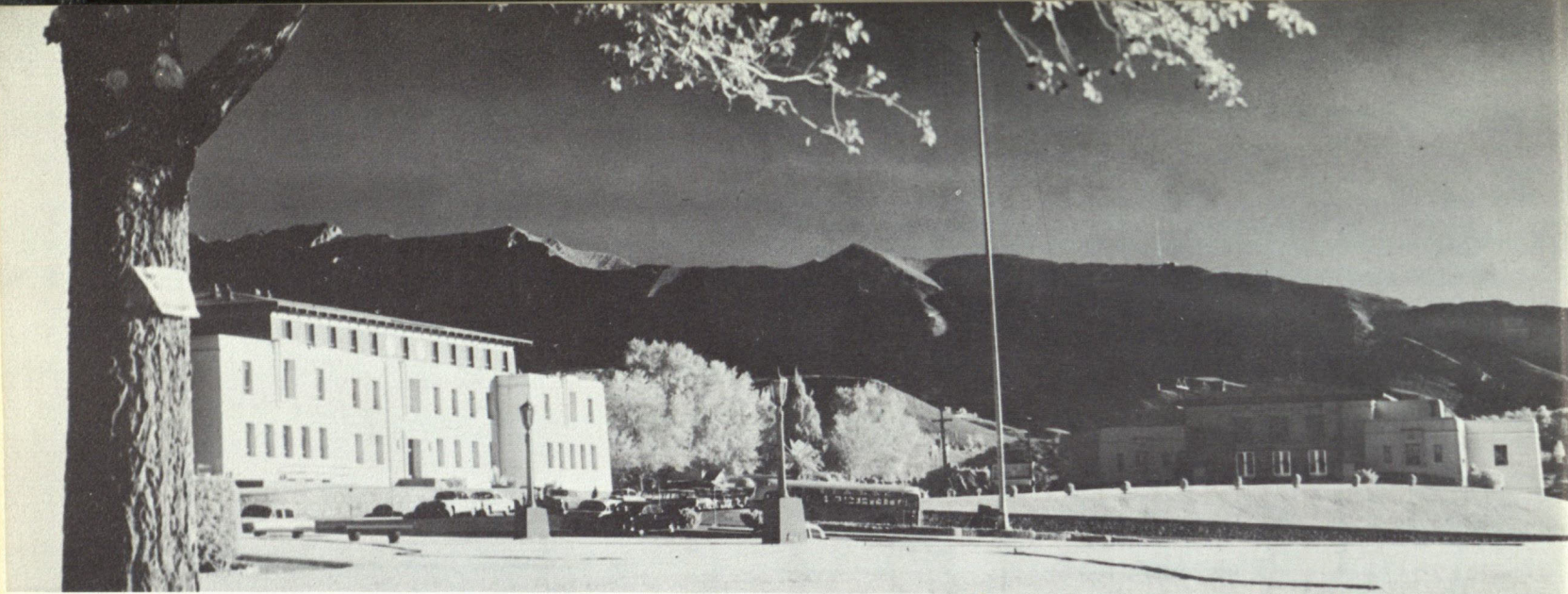

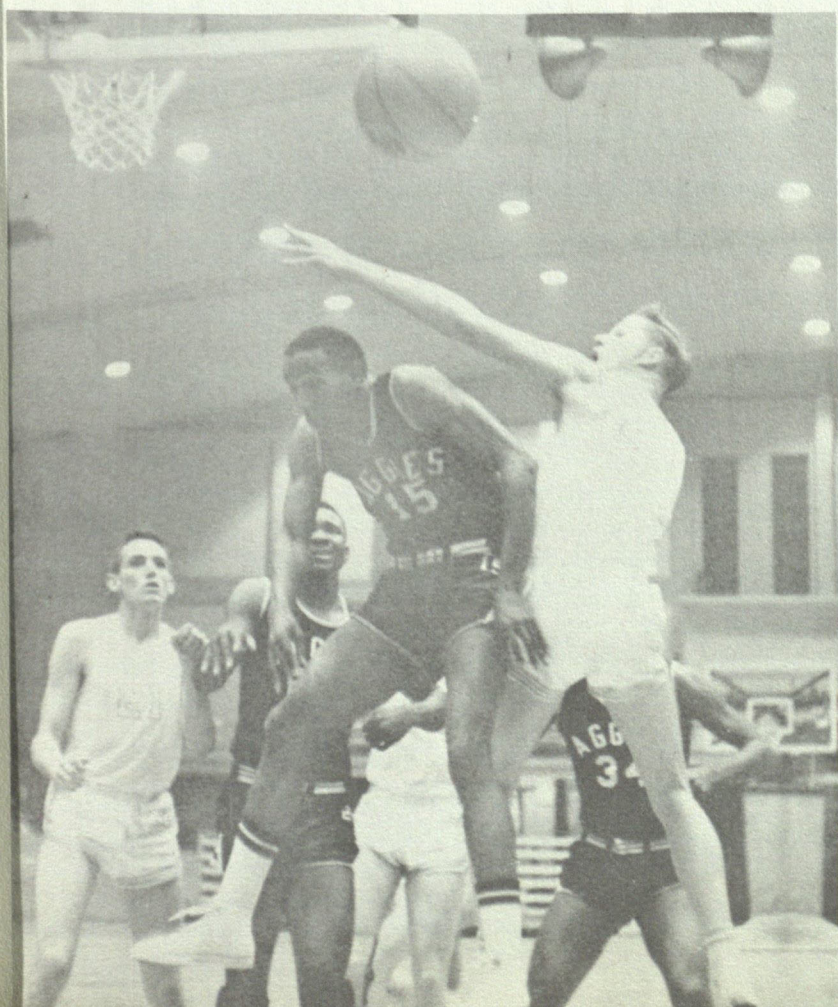

These are the capacities in which Eugene M. Thomas has served Texas Western for 30 years.

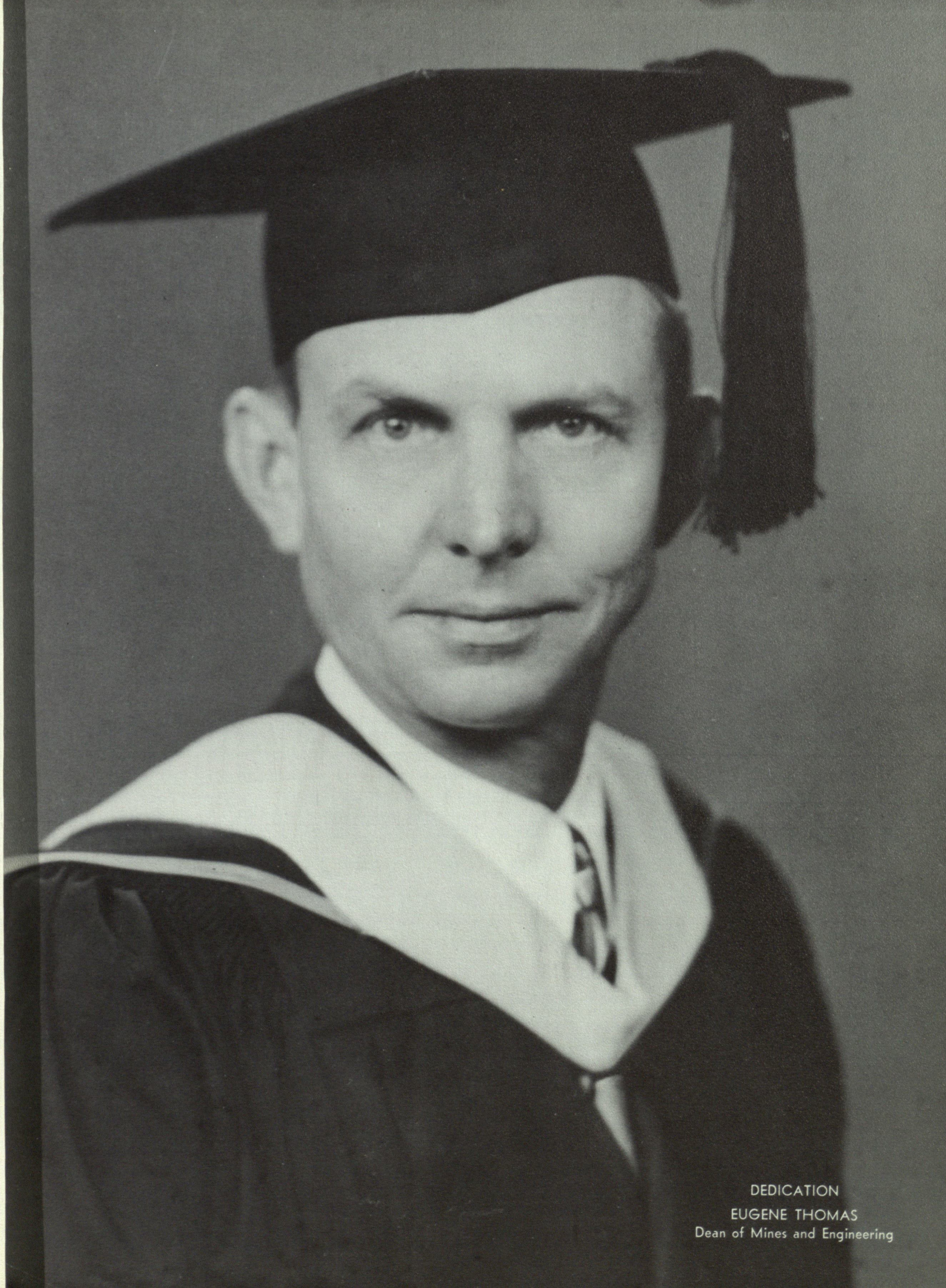

He received a Master of Science in metallurgy from Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1939 and the Engineer of Mines degree from TCM in 1940.

He became Dean of Engineering in 1942, and has served the College and the Engineering Department well, turning out engineers and helping the College become one of the leading engineering schools in the country.

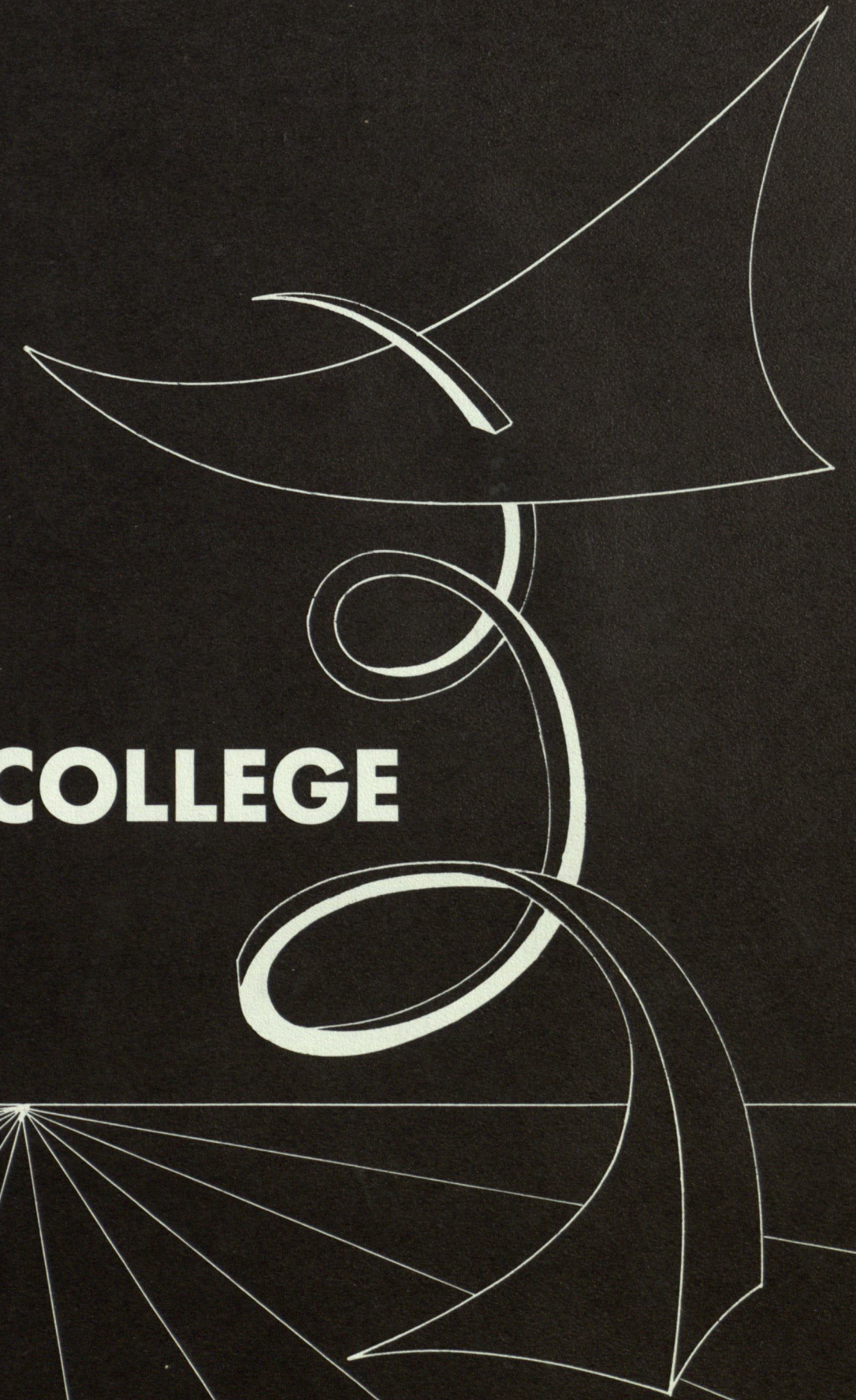
Dean Thomas was acting president of the College for three months in 1948. He is a registered engineer and has worked in the industries of the growing Southwest.

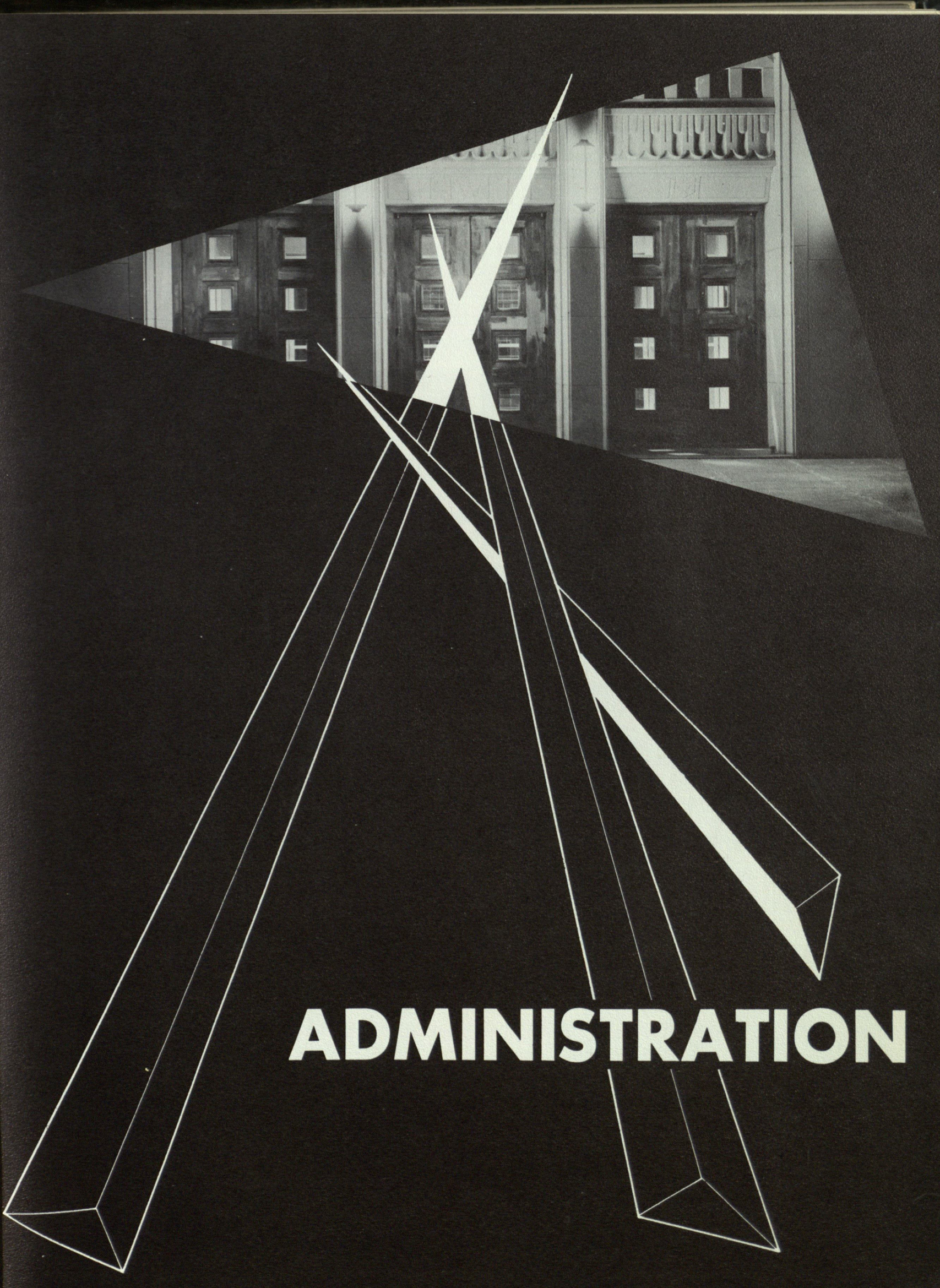

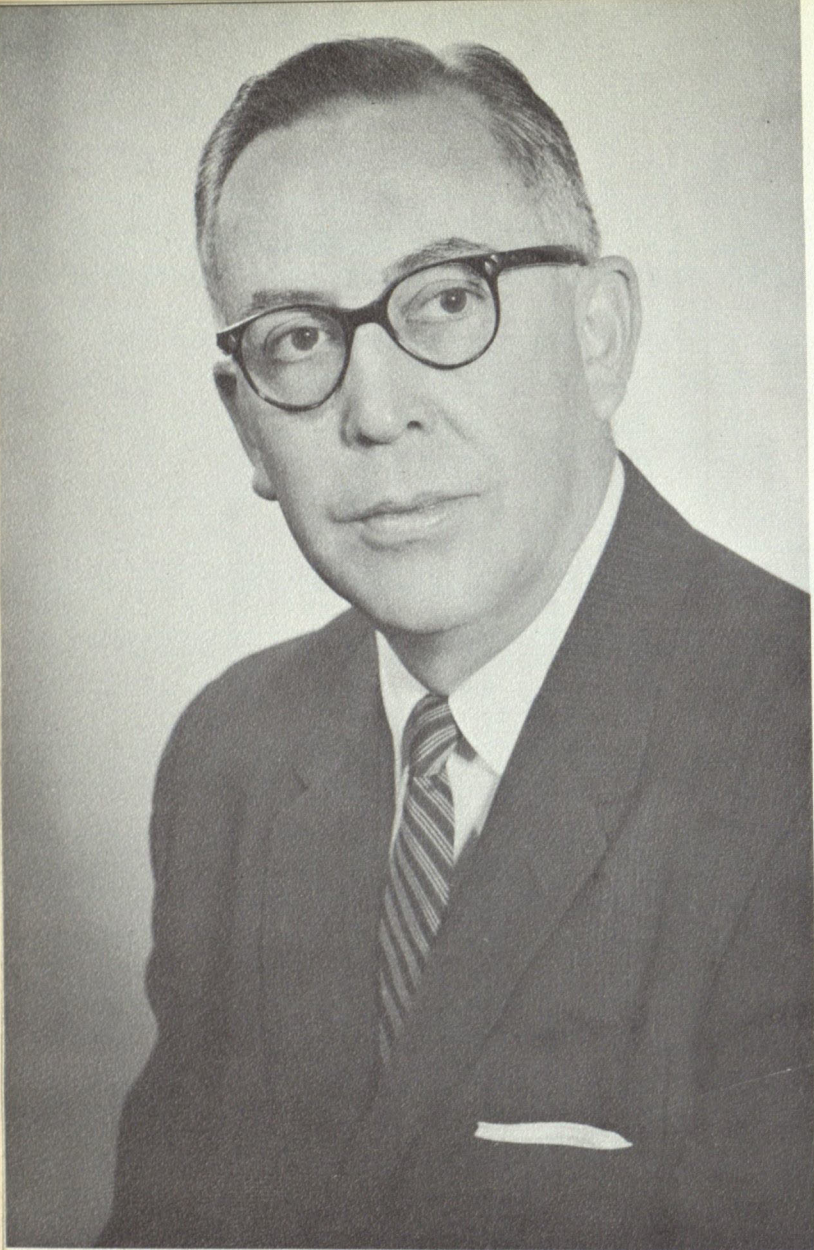

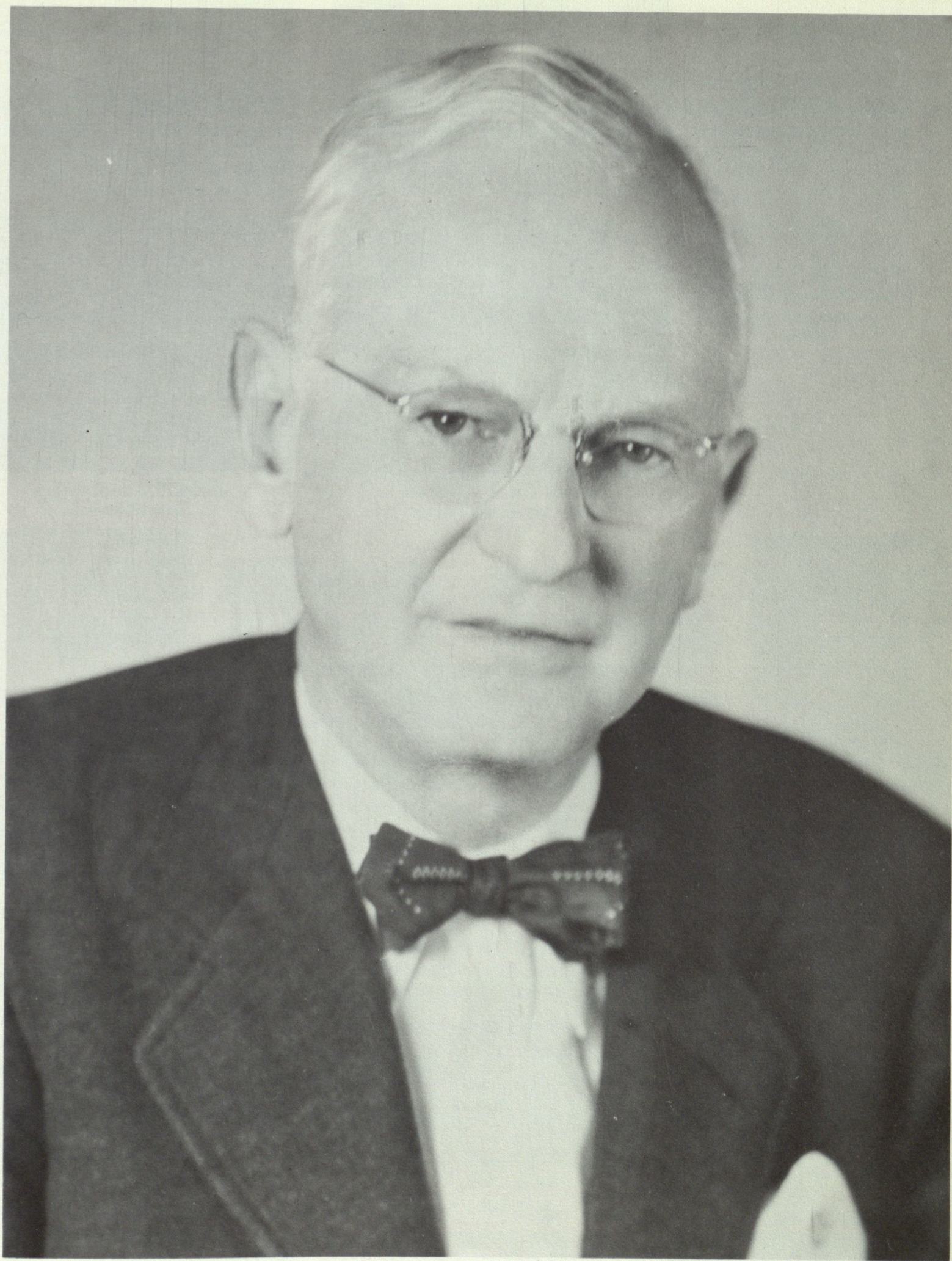
To the Editors and Staff of the Flowsheet of 1960

Not a single penalty was stepped off against the Miners, which is not only an oddity but possibly a record for Border Conference competition.



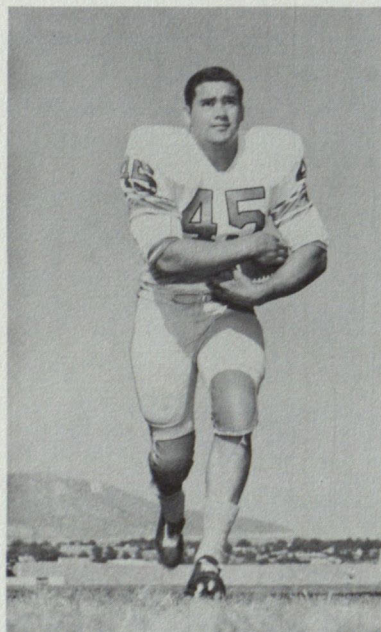

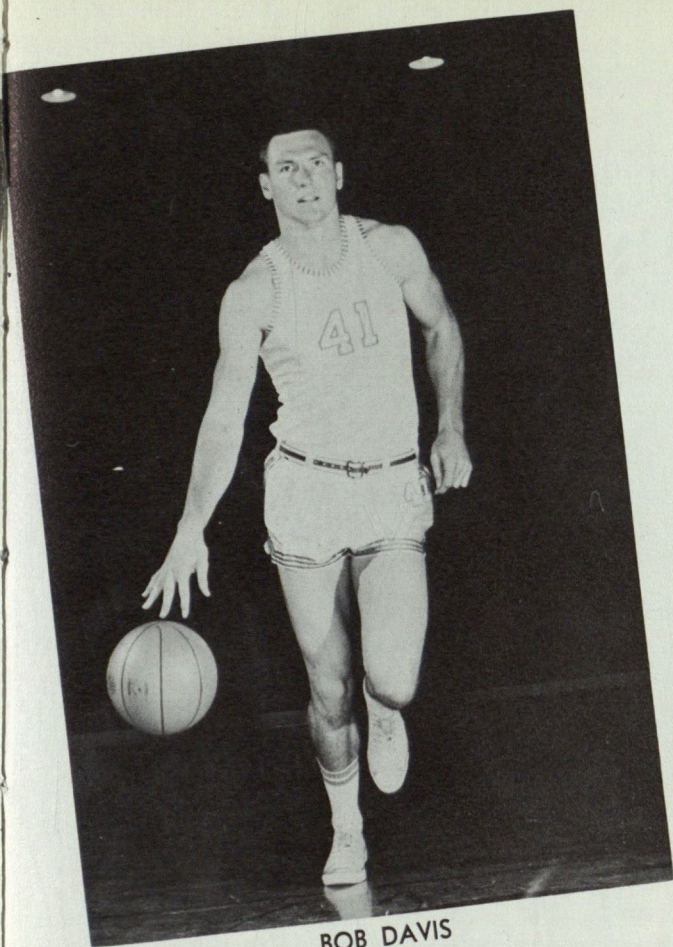
In the Miners' opening game of their home season, they passed to the Aggies who picked up the Miners at the mid-court and took advantage of some bad TWC passes to press their defense home.

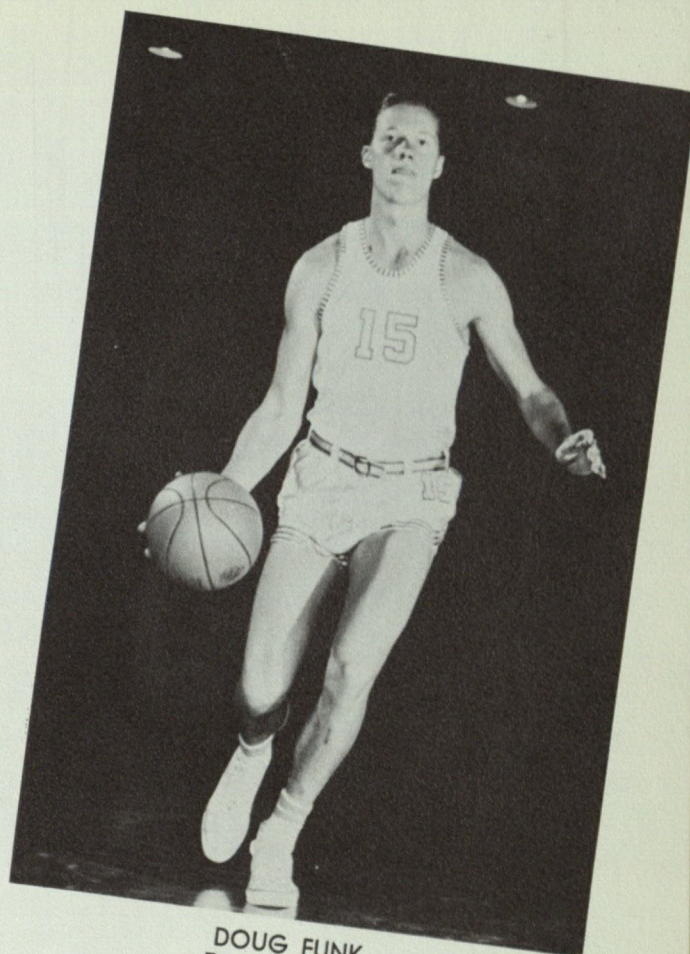
The Miners hit five shots in the field in the first half, and six shots in the second, and twice stole the ball from the Aggies.

Bob Davis led the Miners' scoring men with 14 points, and Al Tolen came up from the field to collect free throws to total 12 points.



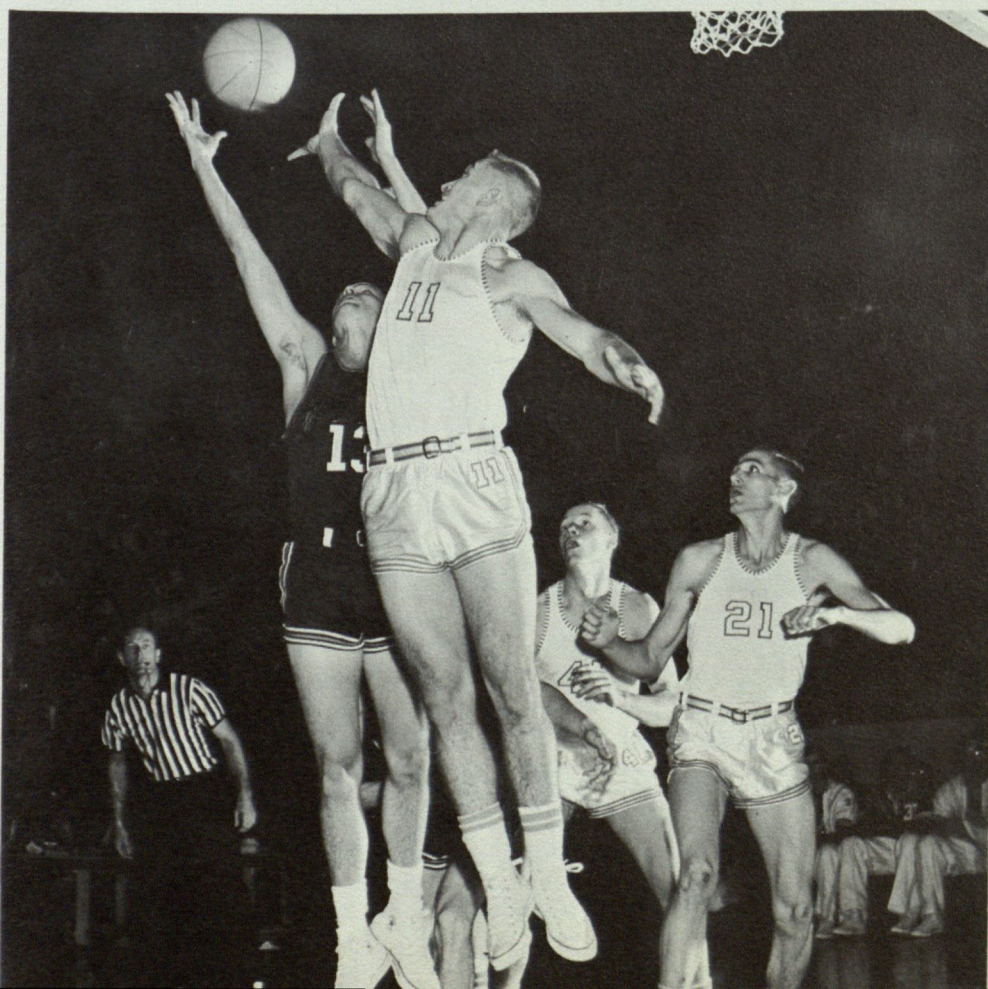

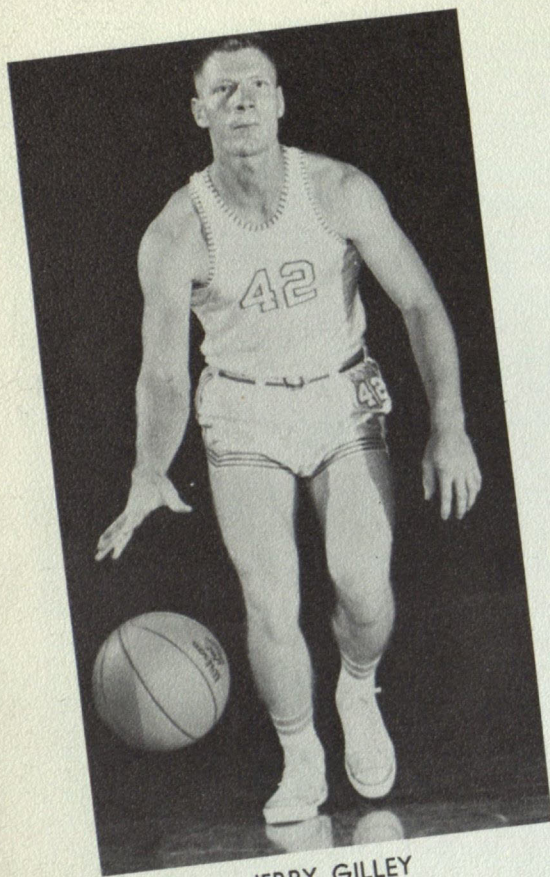


It was a touch-and-go game all the way as the Miners finally tipped over Abilene Christian in over-time to get their victory.

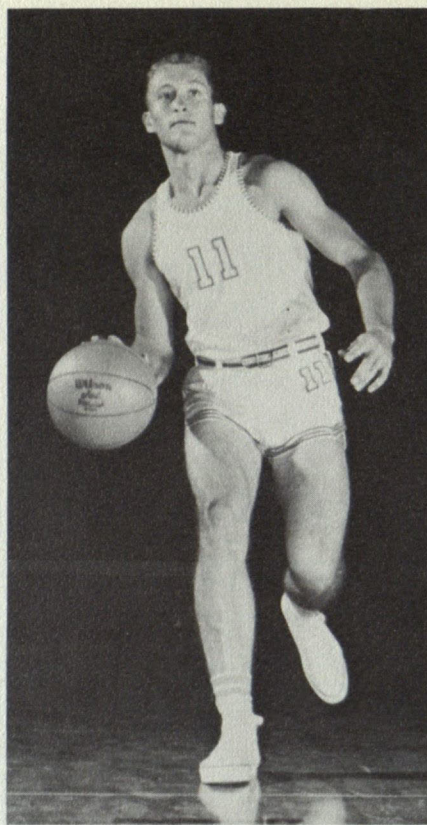

Tolen racked up 23 points to lead on the Miner scoring board. Bob Davis scored high with 19 points and Don Vollintine came up close with 14 points.

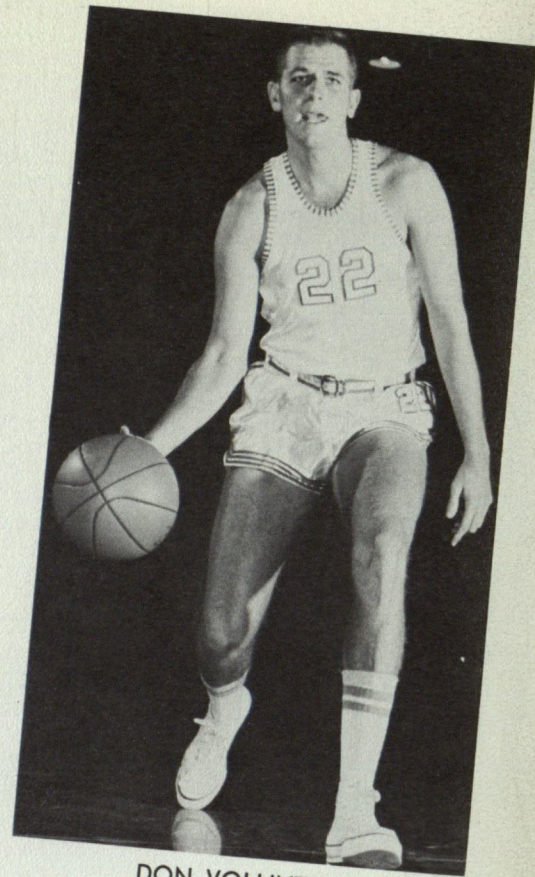
